4. ACADEMICS:

Pupils in classes P.1 to P.6 have progressed well through extensive teaching and continuous assessments that is; B.O.T, MOT, monthly for P.5/P.6 and end of year examinations.

Pupils from P.4 to P.7 are required to bring back their notes exercise books for continuity and revision of already covered work. The books will be checked on arrival.

5. NEW ENTRANTS:

9. CHILD'S PERSONAL REQUIREMENTS:

The school requirements remain the same. These include:-

Pupils' property should be <u>permanently marked</u> <u>with their full names</u> before they are brought to school. Failure to do so, the school administration will take up this responsibility at a fee of <u>5,000/= (Five thousand shillings only)</u> and those with any missing item shall not be accepted in the school until they are all cleared.
